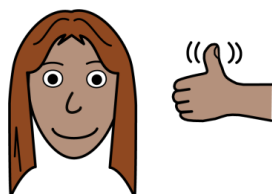


Theme Progress Update



Name of Theme: Being Safe Task Group

Date of last meeting : 27th November 2018



Things that are going well:

- Lots of people came to the first task group meeting. Members are from a range of services and groups. They shared lots of good ideas.
- **Hate and mate crime training with primary schools** – Leep 1 have delivered training at 8 schools and have another 6 booked next year. In July, they will do a performance at Leeds University.
- **Safe Places** - Leep 1 have asked for money from the Big Lottery fund. They will find out in June if they are to get some. If they do, it will pay for 4 people with learning disabilities to be Safe Places quality checkers, run monthly Safe Places trails around Leeds and put on a street performance with the Bright Sparks theatre group. West Yorkshire Police Cadets will help audit the Safe Places as part of their training. The Premier Inn hotel chain are interested in joining the scheme.





- **Safe Mark badge** - West Yorkshire Police have asked for money to pay for a Safe Mark badge which people can wear **if** they want to. It will help identify where people are vulnerable/and or have hidden disabilities. The Police will find out in February if they can have this money.
- **Hate Crime** – The Police are looking at which areas have the most **reported** hate crime. If people don't report crime, we won't have an accurate picture of the problem. This information is important.



Things that are not going well:

- We need to get better at training people how to report hate, mate and date crime.



How can the Partnership Board help?

- In March 2019, the Board will invite lots of people to a Being Safe event.



Who else (outside the Partnership Board) can help us with these issues?
