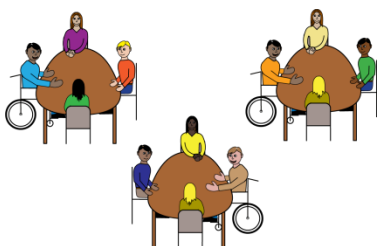




What is a task group?

The role of a task group is to focus on pieces of work and try to finish them, or make things better. It must have the right people on the Task Group to do this – such as professionals and experts by experience.

A task group is different to a reference group or Peoples Parliament – these groups are much bigger. These groups meet to collect the views of a wide range of people and feedback to or report to professionals and the Partnership Board.

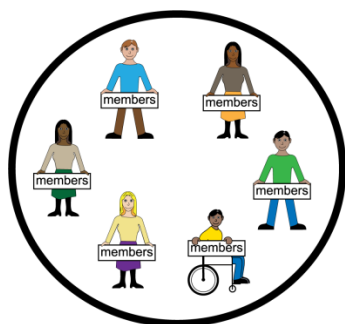
