Making sure that the online activities are in small groups so easier for people to enjoy. Smaller groups but things happening more often.
	Sarah talked about the online training that Connect in the North is running. There is also a quiz every Friday.

I have the information I need to get involved in the activities on offer in Leeds 4. I am supported to make and keep friends and have relationships 5. I am supported to explore my sexuality and gender identity It was agreed that Sarah will send out a questionnaire to all organisations in January so that all organisations can promote online activities also how organisations are delivering training courses. It will be a useful tool for all organisations.
